PRIORITISED INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT TO IMPROVE CONNECTIVITY ACROSS A 17,000+ ISLAND NATION:

As an archipelago nation, the development of sea transportation, river transportation and ferry networks across Indonesia remain a top priority within the Indonesian Government's infrastructure development agenda.

Investment in these networks accounts for 16% of the total US\$368.9 billion investment required to meet the government's National Medium Term Plan 2015-2019.

This investment is needed to facilitate improved passenger transport across Indonesia and to accommodate the estimated doubling of cargo volume by 2030.


